Fall Driving Safety Tips!

Fall can be a beautiful time of year in Southwestern Pennsylvania, but with shortened days, wet leaves, fog, and deer, we know that being an alert driver is critically important. Being aware of, and adjusting your driving habits for the changing conditions each season brings, can help keep you safe while driving.

[PennDOT](#) offers helpful tips for all drivers in the region during fall:



- Increase your following distance in severe weather, at dusk and dawn, and when in an area with wet leaves
- Check your vehicle's headlights, taillights, and turn signals to ensure they are working properly
- Have your vehicle's heating and wiper systems checked to ensure they are working properly
- Be sure you have tires with sufficient tread depth in case of an early season snow.

The Southwestern Pennsylvania Commission (SPC) hereby gives public notice that it is the policy of the Commission to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, Executive Order 12898 on Environmental Justice, and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI and other related statutes require that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, sex, national origin, age, or disability, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which SPC receives federal financial assistance. Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice by SPC under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with the Commission. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with SPC's Title VI Coordinator within one hundred eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
