Nine New Vanpools Headed to the Cranberry Area

Nine new vanpool groups are traveling from various parts of the region to Cranberry area helping employees find an easy, cost-effective way to work. This means there are now 53 CommuteInfo vanpools traveling to 7 destinations in southwestern Pennsylvania.

CommuteInfo Continues to Grow

In 2011, the CommuteInfo saw continued growth in the number of commuters participating in the program. In total, over 1,000 commuters per day participate in a CommuteInfo carpool or vanpool. 1,138 new commuters were added to the ride matching database, a 33% increase over the 854 commuters added in 2010. CommuteInfo also saw a 20% increase in the number of calls from commuters requesting information about transit, vanpools, carpools, bikepools and park-n-ride facility locations.
